

Resident Rotation Definitions

- Acute Care Imaging
 - ACI AM: 7am-3pm ACI shift on weekends and holidays
 - ACI PM: 2pm-10pm ACI shift on weekends and holidays
 - ACI Swing: 8pm-2am ACI shift with focus on VA studies and inpatients
 - ACI Nights: 10pm-7am ACI shift with focus on ED and inpatients
 - Neuro/ACI: 12pm-5pm UU Neuro reading room, 5pm-10pm ACI shift with focus on ED and urgent care
 - VA-Nucs/ACI: 10am-5pm VA Nuclear imaging, 5pm-8pm ACI shift with focus on VA studies and inpatients
 - ACI Elective: Added to above assignment to define it is an elective rather than core requirement.
- Body Imaging
 - Body FL/CT: 8am-5pm assigned to fluoro studies (including performing fluoro studies in the absence of the RA), body XRs, and body CTs
 - Body CT: 8am-5pm assigned to body CTs
 - Body CT/MR Elective: 12pm-8pm assigned to body MRs
 - Body Elective: Added to above assignment to define it is an elective rather than core requirement.
- Breast Imaging
 - Breast Dx HCH: 8am-5pm assigned at HCH to diagnostic mammography and procedures
 - Breast FHC: 8am-5pm assigned at FHC to screening and diagnostic mammography
 - Breast Screens HCH: 8am-5pm assigned at HCH to screening mammography and breast MRs
 - Breast SHHC: 8am-5pm assigned at SHHC to screening and diagnostic mammography
 - Breast SJHC: 8am-5pm assigned at SJHC to screening and diagnostic mammography
 - Breast Elective: Added to above assignment to define it is an elective rather than core requirement.
- Cardiothoracic Imaging
 - Cardiac: 8am-5pm reading cardiac CTs and MRs
 - CTI 1: 7am-4pm reading chest XRs and CTs
 - CTI 2: 8am-5pm reading chest XRs and CTs
 - CTI 3: 9am-6pm reading chest XRs and CTs
 - Chest Elective: Added to above assignment to define it is an elective rather than core requirement.
- Interventional Radiology
 - IR Clinic: Attending clinic with IR attending. Location and time depending on attending
 - IR HCH: 7am-5pm IR procedures at Huntsman
 - IR HCH 2: 7am-5pm IR procedures at Huntsman
 - IR HCH CT: 7am-5pm CT-guided IR procedures at Huntsman
 - IR UUHC: 7am-5pm IR procedures at UU
 - IR Lite: 7am-5pm small IR procedures at UU with the PA/NP, no call element
 - IR Call: Weekday home call 5pm-7am, Weekend home call and inpatient rounding
 - IR Elective: Added to above assignment to define it is an elective rather than core requirement.
 - ESIR - IR ICU: MICU or SICU at UU

- ESIR - IR Neuro: Neuro IR procedures at UU
- ESIR - IR Peds: Peds IR procedures at PCH
- ESIR - IR Spine: Spine IR procedures at CNC
- Musculoskeletal Imaging
 - MSK UOC: 8am-5pm at UOC reading MSK XRs, CTs, and MRs
 - MSK UU: 8am-5pm at UU reading MSK XRs, CTs, and MRs
 - MSK Elective: Added to above assignment to define it is an elective rather than core requirement.
- Neuroradiology
 - Neuro CNC: 8am-4pm at CNC reading outpatient Neuro XRs, CTs, and MRs
 - Neuro Outpatient UUHC: Pending
 - Neuro UUHC: 7am-4pm at UU reading ED and inpatient Neuro XRs, CTs, and MRs
 - Neuro HCH Elective: Pending
 - Neuro Spine Elective: Spine procedures at CNC
 - Neuro Elective: Added to above assignment to define it is an elective rather than core requirement.
- Nuclear Imaging
 - Nucs: 8am-5pm at UU reading Nuc studies and administrating radiotherapies
 - Nucs Elective: Added to above assignment to define it is an elective rather than core requirement.
- Pediatric Imaging
 - Peds: Please see itinerary from Pediatric Education Coordinator
 - Peds Elective: Added to above assignment to define it is an elective rather than core requirement.
- Ultrasound
 - US 1: First US rotation split between scanning with the techs and reading body US
 - US 2: Second US rotation, includes some OB on some days for exposure
 - US 3: Third US rotation, may include OB on some days depending on needs
 - OB Elective: Reading OB/US with OB radiologists, scanning with techs on other days
- VA Rotations
 - VA Body: 8am-5pm at VA reading body XRs, US, CTs, and MRs
 - VA CTI: 8am-5pm at VA reading chest XRs, chest CTs, cardiac CTs, and cardiac MRs
 - VA Fluoro: 8am-5pm at VA performing fluoro procedures and reading MSK XRs
 - VA IR: 7am-5pm IR procedures at VA, vascular US, and CTA runoffs
 - VA MSK: 8am-5pm reading MSK MRs/CTs, staffing out at UU
 - VA Neuro 1: 8am-5pm reading neuro XRs, CTs, and MRs
 - VA Neuro 2: 8am-5pm reading neuro XRs, CTs, and MRs
 - VA Chief: Responsible for tumor board, VA staffing, and other administrative tasks
